60.3(d)

The following model ordinance pertains only to the special flood hazard areas in a community that participates in the Regular Program Phase of the National Flood Insurance Program (rather than the Emergency Program Phase). It has been designed to meet minimum Federal requirements as published in Title 44 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Not all sections in this model ordinance may be applicable to a community that wishes to adopt a floodplain management ordinance. Before adoption, this model ordinance should be thoroughly studied by community officials, planning commissions, and the community's attorney, as to its adequacy and suitability to the community's needs. This will ensure that the community's specific floodplain management issues are governed in a reasonable manner without inflicting unnecessary hardships on people living in flood-prone areas.

This model does not prohibit development in the special flood hazard areas. It does set forth minimum performance standards for new construction or substantially improved structures. AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLA VILLA, MISSOURI CHRONIC NUISANCE PROPERTY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BELLA VILLA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Chronic Nuisance Property

- A. Chronic nuisance property means property on which or within two hundred (200) feet of which any person associated with the property has engaged in three (3) or more nuisance activities during any twelve-month period.
- B. Nuisance activity means any of the following unlawful conduct:
 - a. Illegal use, possession or distribution of drug or drug paraphernalia as defined by the laws of the city or the state; or
 - b. Illegal possession or use of marijuana as defined by the laws of the city or the state; or
 - c. Illegal possession, use or sale of firearms or weapons as defined by the laws of the city or the state; or
 - d. Prostitution or patronizing prostitution, as defined by the laws of the city or the state; or
 - e. Drinking alcoholic beverages in public places as defined by the laws of the city or the state; or
 - f. Disorderly conduct defined by the laws of the city or the state; or
 - g. Attempting bodily injury as defined in by the laws of the city or the state; or
 - h. Any activity that constitutes a felony or misdemeanor under federal or state law.

Provided, however, that the grounds for determining a chronic nuisance violation for the purposes of this section does not include any request for police protection or any police intervention in the face of a threat or a perceived threat to person or property, or any request for the assistance of the police to enforce a court order, including, but not limited to, circumstances in which the conviction, request for assistance or other police intervention arises from an incident relating to domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault or stalking against any person at or near the premises.

C. If the Chief of Police determines a property to be a chronic nuisance property, the Chief of Police shall send the owner of the property a cease-and-desist letter, describing the nuisance activities affecting the property and requiring the owner or controller to abate the nuisance within thirty (30) days. The owner of the property may meet with the Chief of Police to discuss appropriate abatement measures.

- D. An owner of a property who does not abate the nuisance within the thirty-day period may be issued a summons for failure to abate a nuisance. An owner of property who is found guilty or pleads guilty to such an offense shall be subject to a fine between \$100 and \$500 and up to ninety (90) days in jail.
- E. If, after reviewing the Chief of Police chronic nuisance property report, the Mayor determines that the proper procedures have been followed and that there is reason to believe that the property is a chronic nuisance property; the Mayor may authorize the City Attorney to initiate an administrative action to abate the nuisance. The administrative action shall follow the contested case provisions of Chapter 536 of the Missouri Revised Statutes. The owners of the property and any tenants shall be necessary parties to the action. The Mayor shall designate a hearing officer.

If, after considering all evidence, the hearing officer determines that the property is a chronic nuisance property and that the appropriate procedures were followed, the hearing officer may order appropriate abatement. Abatement may include closure of the property for up to one year, physically securing the property, suspension of utility services during the period of closure and revocation of a certificate of compliance for rental property. If there is more than one residential unit on the property, the hearing officer shall close only the unit or units whose occupants, guests or invitees have engaged in the nuisance activities. The hearing officer shall consider the following factors in determining whether to close a chronic nuisance property:

- (1) The level of cooperation of the property owner and occupants in attempting to prevent nuisance activities;
- (2) The nature and extent of the nuisance activities;
- (3) The impact of the nuisance activities on neighbors and others; and
- (4) Any actions taken to avoid further nuisance activities connected with the property.

If an abatement order is not complied with, the hearing officer may authorize the abatement of the chronic nuisance property by city employees or by persons under contract with the city. No person shall enter private property to enforce an abatement order unless the person in possession of the property has consented to the entry or unless the Municipal Judge has issued a warrant for the entry. The Chief of Police shall certify the cost of abatement under this subsection to the City Clerk. The cost shall include administrative costs as well as the actual cost of abating the nuisance. The City Clerk shall cause a special tax bill against the property to be prepared in the amount of the abatement cost. The tax bill from the date of its issuance shall be a lien on the property until paid and shall be prima facie evidence of the recitals therein and of its validity. No clerical error or informality in the tax bill or in the proceedings leading up to the issuance of the tax bill shall be a defense in an action to collect the tax

bill. Tax bills issued under this section, if not paid when due, shall bear interest at the rate of nine (9) percent per year. The cost of abatement shall also constitute a personal o This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Alderman.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance or with any of its provisions are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

EXHIBIT A CONTRACT FOR STREET AND OUTDOOR LIGHTING SERVICE

THIS CONTRACT, by and between UNION ELECTRIC COMPANY, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, a Missouri corporation, its successors and assigns, hereinafter called "Company", and the City of Bella Villa, hereinafter called "Customer";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Customer has determined that the continued lighting of the streets, alleys and other outdoor public areas is necessary for the convenience or safety of the public and should be provided by contract with Company; and

WHEREAS, Company is a public utility regulated by the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri (hereafter "PSC") in accordance with law;

NOW THEREFORE, Customer does hereby award to Company this contract for lighting within the territorial limits of Customer as they now exist or may hereafter be extended, and within the area thereof which Company now is authorized to serve or may hereafter be authorized to serve; and Customer agrees to pay for and Company agrees to sell and deliver said services in the manner and subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

- 1. <u>Street and Outdoor Area Lighting Service</u>. Initial Street and Outdoor Area Lighting Service supplied by Company on Company-owned facilities or Customerowned facilities shall be of the type and character set forth in Appendix 1 attached hereto. Additional Street and Outdoor Lighting Service may be requested by Customer from time to time and shall be provided pursuant to a written addendum to this contract.
- 2. <u>Tariffs</u>. All service hereunder shall be supplied by Company and paid for by the Customer as provided by the terms and conditions of Company's Rate Schedules 5(M) or 6(M) in effect at the time service is provided, a current copy of which

is attached hereto as Appendix 2. These tariffs may be amended as allowed by state law governing electrical corporations.

- 3. Right to Install Company Facilities. Customer hereby grants to Company, its successors and assigns, while engaged in the performance of Company's duties hereunder, the right and privilege to erect, maintain and operate lighting fixtures, poles, wires, cables, transformers and related apparatus and appliances necessary or convenient for Company's efficient performance of its duties under this contract, upon, under, over, and across the streets, avenues, alleys, and other public places within the territorial limits of Customer.
- 4. <u>Notice</u>. All notices, applications and requests by the Customer hereunder shall be in writing signed by an authorized representative and delivered or mailed to Company addressed as follows or to such other address as Company may hereafter designate in writing to the Customer.
