- Solid Waste/Recyclables Every Thursday except on the Holiday schedule,
- Bulk Items 2 items per month but you must call Republic Waste to schedule.

Trash containers must be removed from the curb within 24 hours after collection. Between collection days containers must be kept 5 feet behind the front of the house. We recently found out anyone with medical problems and unable to take trash out, Republic offers service to do this for you. You must give them notice in advance and have a note from your doctor. Call them for more information.

Our Police Department reminds everyone to lock cars at all times, don't leave cars running and put valuables out of sight. We understand that parking is limited on many streets within the city so if possible use your driveway for parking needs. Street parking is for public use. Emergency vehicles need access to you or your neighbors in case of emergency. Parking on grass is prohibited. Remember do not block sidewalks and driveways and do not park illegally on the wrong side of the street.

School will be out soon and as always we need to be mindful of the children playing outdoors. Enjoy the warm weather and visit our playground at **Elvira Moll Park** (by City Hall). **George Appel Park** (on East Dallas) has a walking path with natural greenery and newly installed park benches and picnic tables for your use.

Many residents have pets. Please be a good neighbor and pick up after them.

REMBER BEFORE ANY OCCUPANCY OR CONSTRUCTION IS INITIATED, A PROPERTY OWNER MUST CONTACT CITY HALL. "This is in force for inspections and permits".

Property owners must contact City Hall to determine if Bella Villa's codes require permits and inspections. Please pay particular attention to fences, concrete slabs and other construction that may require a permit. Any code violations carry penalties and fines assessed by the City of Bella Villa.

For your information: St. Louis County Department of Transportation and Public Works have projects to replace the bridge on Bayless Avenue over Gravois Creek and resurfacing Bayless. These projects have separate construction schedules. The resurfacing of Bayless project is scheduled for construction in the Spring of 2021. The bridge project is scheduled for construction in 2022.

As some of you may know, Bella Villa Officer Joseph Lafrance was injured in a traffic accident last month and hospitalized with significant injuries. Prior to the accident Office Lafrance worked three jobs, including protecting the City of Bella Villa for the past two years. Loved ones are hoping the public will help Officer Lafrance, his wife and two boys, aged 7 and 11, during his recovery and while he is unable to work. The family has set up a Go Fund Me page to help the Lafrance family during his recovery from the accident. Friendly's Sport Bar at 3971 Bayless is also hosting a fundraiser for the Lafrance family on **May 11th from 11am to 7 pm.** We encourage you to support the Lafrance family and keep them in your thoughts.

What is a census?

The census isn't just a population count. It helps allocate federal state and local funds to our community. The federal government decides how much funding or grants to give states, counties and cities by looking at the detailed census data. That means money for updating schools, building new hospitals, repairing broken roads, and maintaining public utilities like water, sewage and electricity.

A representative from the City of Bella Villa will be going door to door to note the number of residents living at your home starting in August 2019.

We recently was awarded a grant through the Non Playground Scrap Tire Surface Material Grant. We received 5 picnic tables and 6 park benches through this grant. These are located for your use in George Appel Park. This is one example of why a correct census is needed.
